Helpful hints for families with young kids:

- Watch the videos as a family, and ask a few questions to make sure your kids understand the story. You can ask simple questions such as: What was the person's story about? How does it show God at work in that person's life?
- Read the Bible text for the day. You can ask your child to read one of the verses. Most of the readings will be short and manageable for the kids to read.
- If you miss a day or a week, don't feel like you have to go back and start again. Start with the day you are on. The goal is not to give you more guilt, but to help your family get in the practice of being in the Word together.

Suggested format for doing family devotions:

- Ask about Highs and Lows for the day
- Video
- Booklet Bible verse reading
- Answer the questions
- Pray
