IMPORTANT ONE LEGACY UPDATE AND CEREMONIAL GROUNDBREAKING EVENT!

Set your calendar and save the date for Saturday, October 6 at 9:00 AM! That morning we will gather together as a St. John church and school family to give thanks for all the Lord's faithfulness throughout the years, and break ground on all that is ahead! Immediately after this special service of prayer and celebration, we will go out together as God's people to serve our community as His Church! At the same time, praise the Lord that contributions in follow-up to \$3.5 million in pledges continue to be strong! In fact, as anticipated this past week, we have officially surpassed the \$1 million milestone in gifts received! Thank you, St. John family, for your ongoing generosity!

The project itself is very extensive and while we are making great progress, developments in the last couple weeks have unfortunately led to an anticipated slower construction timeline than we had initially hoped for and communicated this summer. While this is disappointing, we've been reminded that delays are not unusual for a project of this scope, and our leadership is committed to proceeding in the best way possible as we carefully steward the blessings the Lord has provided. Watch for a FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) email update and Congregation Forum date coming soon. May the Lord continue to









bless these efforts for the future! Please keep for the Lord's guidance and provision for all that is ahead. These are truly exciting times!

EXCITING ONE LEGACY MISSION TITHE UPDATE!

While we wait with anticipation for all that is ahead with new construction and renovation work on our campus in the coming year, the mission tithe (10%) portion of our ONE Legacy Initiative is on the verge of making a huge global impact!

As shared with our congregation this past spring, one of the chosen grant recipients of this tithe is St. Peter Church and School in Middelburg, South Africa. It was just over a year ago that our Michigan District President, David Maier contacted us to ask if our church and school family could prayerfully consider hosting Pastor Mandla



Khumalo as a guest preacher on Reformation weekend. If you were there, you know the powerful impact he had on us that day... and a new partnership was formed!

This fall our St. John family was privileged to assist in funding \$20,000 (half the total installation cost) of a solar energy project on the St. Peter campus that will assist in alleviating 80% ofcosts and freeing up more financial resources for educating over 850 students - many of whom live below the poverty level. This grant partnership is in addition to other capital improvements being made in Middelburg by *Here We Stand* funding through our Michigan District. Last weekend in worship, we were pleased to welcome representatives from St. Peter Lutheran Church and School/Christian Outreach For Africa (COFA) including Pastor Khumalo's son Muzi, who came to receive this grant!



In tandem with this effort, as was also announced this spring, Pastor Marc has been working with a district initiated task group that has been finalizing details to bring Mandla Khumalo to Michigan beginning as early as November for a period of two years as a missionary-at-large. His focus will be cross-cultural evangelism, as well as helping our church body develop a clear vision for racial reconciliation in Jesus.

In mid-October, representatives from our

district will be traveling to South Africa to celebrate Pastor Khumalo's ministry and mission partnership with our district. Pastor Marc was recently invited to take part in this mission relationship building trip. After several days of prayer and consultation with our Vestry, he along with our Vestry Chair, Dave Halverson have decided to go and represent our St. John family. Trip costs will be offset by a separate designated International Missions Fund, not the ONE Legacy tithe. **Please** keep all of this in prayer as we praise the Lord for this incredible opportunity to make a difference in Jesus' name.
