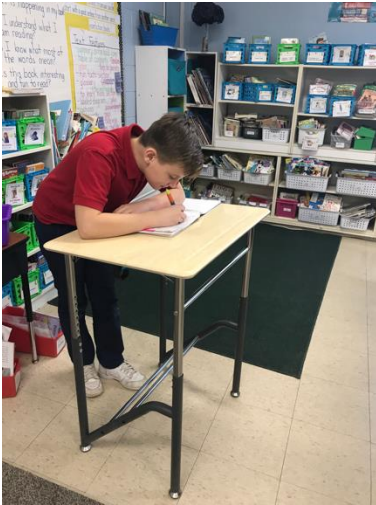

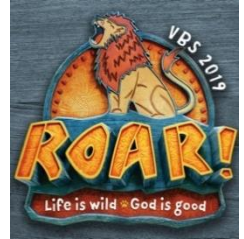

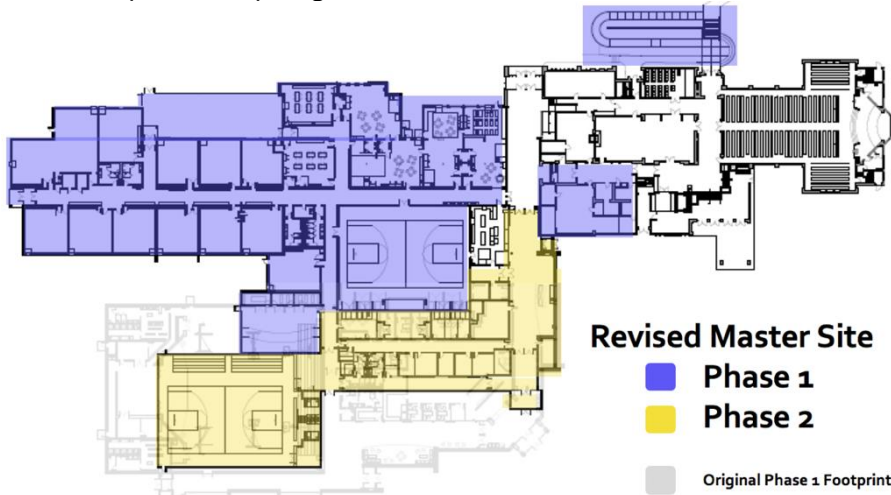
ONE LEGACY UPDATE!
