## SERVANT OPPORTUNITIES AT ST. JOHN LUTHERAN SCHOOL

There are many opportunities during the school year where volunteers are welcome to help support this important ministry. Please be aware that volunteer positions within the school may require a background check, particularly those that involve interaction with students. Specific contact names and emails are listed. Athletics (All Gifts) - Scorers, concession workers, clock monitors, coaches and fans are needed at all athletic events. Contact Athletic Director Todd Bauer for information at tbauer@stjohnrochester.org.

**Auction (Administration, Giving, Discernment)** - Help be a part of this biennial church and school event that includes a dinner and auction, held offsite to raise funds for the school. Volunteer support needed includes securing sponsors, ads and donations; helping with the event day logistics such as vendors, seating and onsite auction setup. **Book Fair (Service, Giving) -** Each November, the school hosts a week-long Scholastic Book Fair to benefit the school Media Center. Volunteers are needed to help with setup, sales, and teardown.

**Chromebook Helpers (Encouraging, Teacher, Pastor/Shepherd)** - Help students with their computer skills for about 30 minutes per week. Students receive instruction from a St. John teacher; helpers provide additional assistance to students.
